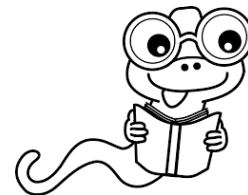

This means that with a Plum Creek Library card, you have access to nearly every audiobook produced by Brilliance Books. Get signed up for the service at the <http://www.plumcreeklibrary.org/> or the Lake Benton Public Library's website. Audiobooks can be checked out for three weeks and will returned automatically at that point. Connect digital devices to the service with an app. If you need help getting set up, stop by the Lake Benton Public Library soon.
